Boys and Girls Club of Hill County	\$36,500	Purchase of security cameras to meet standards set by the Boys and Girls Club of America; to provide funds to be used toward debt reduction on the new club facility.
City of Itasca	\$24,000	Purchase of equipment to upgrade the basketball court, benches, picnic tables and trees of Crouch Park.
Covington Volunteer Fire Department	\$17,500	Purchase of a defibrillator/vital monitor to replace the current model that is no longer serviceable and is not current with emergency medicine standards.
Child Protective Services of Hill County	\$10,000	Purchase of clothing twice per year for each child in the Hill County foster care system.
City of Blum Fire and Rescue	\$10,000	Purchase of bunker gear for firefighters to meet current safety standards.
Lake Whitney Chamber of Commerce	\$9,400	Funding for the 2024 Wild Wonders Summer Camp for youth in Hill County independent school districts.
Woodbury Community Center Association	\$2,600	Funding to replace tile flooring in the kitchen area to improve safety and to remain consistent with flooring in the auditorium area.
